3. Discuss Bicycle Commission's Bicycle Safety Month Activities

Chief Herdegen let the Commission know that the Mayor read a proclamation recognizing the month of May as Bicycle Safety Awareness month at the previous board meeting. Rachel and Elliot attended a Bike Friendly Illinois summit at UIC which discussed bicycle safety in the community, current projects, and funding opportunities. Elliot also talked about a Destination Imagination project that students at Copeland Manor School participated in which several students road their bikes to school.

4. Discuss Bicycle Friendly Initiative Newspaper Article

Ken Glick stated how the Daily Harold reached out to him to provide information about the Bicycle Commission's initiatives and the Bicycle Friendly status that the Commission has applied for. Elliot volunteered to write an article for the paper describing the activities which he said will be placed in the paper later this summer.

5. Other

- Commissioner Pomeroy let the Commission know that the Bicycle Friendly Community application had been reviewed and the Village received an honorable mention. This application was a starting point which gave critical feedback as to how to go about improving bicycle friendliness within the Village.
- Community Bike Ride planning took place. Ken Glick stated that a bank in Libertyville was willing to sponsor the event and will follow up with them to coordinate the sponsorship. Staff will look into placing an advertising banner within Cook Park in order to bring attention to the ride. Staff will also look into creating an online submission form for easier registration.
