

**MINUTES OF THE
VILLAGE OF LIBERTYVILLE
BOARD OF FIRE AND POLICE COMMISSIONERS
MARCH 15, 2017**

Commissioner BORGSTROM called to order the meeting of the Village of Libertyville Board of Fire and Police Commissioners at 5:30PM in the UPSTAIRS CONFERENCE ROOM at the Libertyville FIRE Department at 1551 N Milwaukee Ave, Libertyville.

Pursuant to the Rules and Regulations of The Village of Libertyville Board of Fire and Police Commissioners, Fire Entry-level Candidate AUSTIN YARC was provided the opportunity to address the Commission. Candidate YARC concluded his remarks and exited the meeting at approximately 5:40 PM

The Commission allowed Libertyville Firefighter Andrew Yarc, Libertyville Fire LT Mike Stanek, and Libertyville Firefighter Michelle Mayer to individually address the Commission. A letter from Libertyville Covenant Lutheran Church Pastor Bob Davis to the Commission was acknowledged.

The Commission reviewed its initial findings and decision, the statements of Candidate Austin Yarc and others with interest, and let stand its prior action, of not offer a firefighter position to Austin Yarc.
